
# Q1 Do you believe you have suffered unintended outcomes from using a particular medical device/implant or procedure?







Nearly 3 years down the line the nauseous and pain is still there. Ive been fobbed off. Suffering constantly. Had to give up work and the gym. Put on so much weight. Now my teeth are rotten under the gum line. Ive suffered collapses and neurology issues. No one seems to know why but it all started nearly 3 years ago. My neurologist and dentist are convinced its due to the mesh. My Gp is bo help saying its psychosomatic even though a psychologist said its clearly not. They are saying im suffering anxiety. 
I reported the adverse outcomes to a different hospital (public) to a different surgeon (original surgeon was as a private patient) after a referral from my GP when a large lump started forming above the site of the mesh and under the scar. The usual reaction was this happens, and it is a foreign body, and it should be easily solved through more surgery.  When I went back to see the surgeon months after surgery as the pain was not was not getting better was to say this happens to some people we don't know why and he offered to give me contizone injections. In 44 and dolf want to go down that route as there are some severe side effects from long farm use of cortizone. Have been referred to pain specialist, but they have not recognised the mesh as the problem. GP keeps trying to find other causes for the pain in the belly above the incision down to the groin. The GP discounted it as post op pain. When the stitlen popped 2 –3 month later and lump appeared in my belly where it popped lement to another GP who sent me to the surgicial department where I was seen a few weeks after and told a sitch securing the mesh had been ripped out and the rerve pein was an irritated nerve.  The strongly denied that it was the mesh, and suggested that time might lesson things which it harsn't. My GP has suggested some very strong pain intervention medication, that I am reluctant to start taking, partly because I can still function pretty much as I did before the op, albeit with some discomfort.  Some 6 months after the surgery I saw the surgeon and asked if the ongoing pain was normal - he told me full recovery would take up to 12 months and added that I was possibly one of the "unlucky" small percentage of patients who expendence chronic pain following this type of surgery. 


